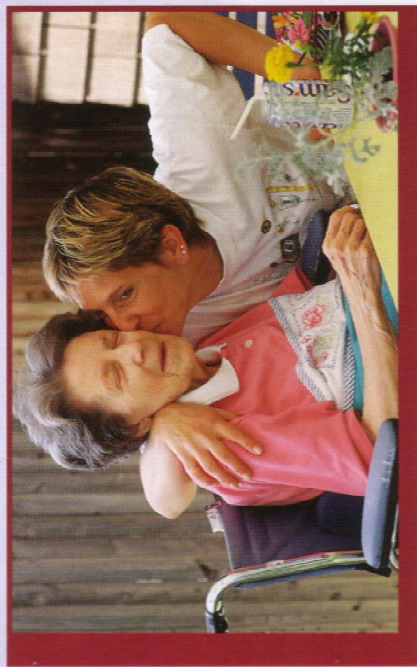

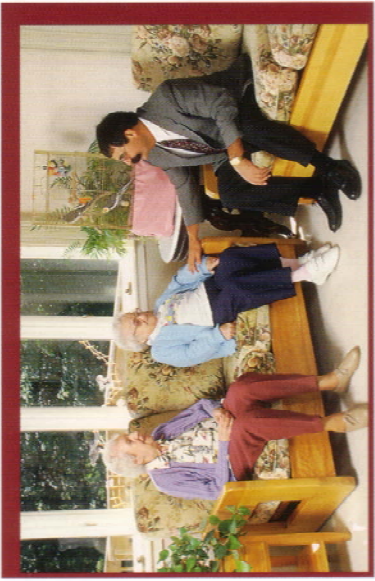

Levels of Service

The Gill Odd Fellows Home of Vermont, Inc., offers those individuals in need of our services three levels of care:

Skilled Nursing Facility

Medicare Certified — Level I:

designed for persons in need of extensive licensed nursing care and/or rehabilitation therapy services after a three-day hospital stay.

Intermediate Nursing Care Facility

Medicaid Certified — Level II:

designed for persons requiring maintenance and supportive care to perform their activities of daily living.

Community Care Home

Level III:

designed for persons in need of room, board, health care overview, and nighttime supervision.

Quality Care

All our residents are admitted under the care of a primary physician. Licensed nursing coverage is provided 24 hours a day, including IV management, pain management, wound management, enteral nutrition services, and restorative nursing program to maintain function and ability. In addition to these services, dentistry, podiatry, x-ray, and ambulance services are available to our residents through contracts.

Rehabilitation Therapies are provided in-house — both short and long term — through a contracted therapy company. Occupational, Speech, and Physical Therapists visit and treat our residents as their physician orders. Discharge Planning for your return home includes home evaluations, and medical and nursing follow-up.
