

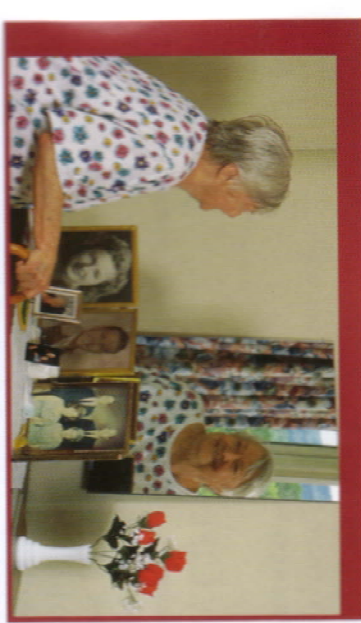
At the Call Odd Fellows Home of Vermont, Inc., we have a dedicated Admission Coordinator to assist you in making the decision for placement by:
